Entries & Eligibility

- All entries must be completed by 8 August allowing time to contact Schools for Principle sign off. Entries can be done in two ways
 - Individually through Snowplanets website with payment <u>https://bookings.snowplanet.co.nz/book/snowplanet-events/634</u>
 - As a school entry via Registration form sent to <u>michelle@snowplanet.co.nz</u>, an invoice will be sent for payment.

Every student who competes must be a full time student at the given school and follow SSNZ eligibility criteria <u>https://www.schoolsportnz.org.nz/Sport-1/Events/eligibility-regulations-1</u>

Entry Requirements

- Helmets are **mandatory** (Helmets can be rented at Snowplanet).
- All athletes must be able to link turns in control from the top of Snowplanet and ride the platter lift unassisted.

Cost:

\$85 per athlete

Event Schedule

- 7:00 AM Facility opens, number pick-up begins
- 8:00 AM Athlete briefing, All athletes must be on-site
- 8:30 AM Event start
- 1:00 PM (approx.) Event completion

• Schools may enter an unlimited number of athletes.

Event Format

- Race: 4 runs, combined time GS
- Slopestyle: 1 judged run, top athletes advance to a second judged run

Competition Rules

- Start orders **cannot be changed** after finalization.
- **Re-runs** are permitted only due to external interference (e.g., another racer or timing malfunction).
- No competitor, manager, or parent may forerun or maintain the course.

Protests

- Protests must be in writing on an official protest form.
- A **\$100 non-refundable fee** applies.
- Protested disqualifications will be decided by a Jury.
- Protest jury: Event Manager, Chief of Race/Slopestyle, and one course official.
- Jury decisions are **final**.

Race Rules

- Racers must compete in **run sheet order**.
- Course inspection is visual only. This means no slip of the course.
- Racers must pass through all gates and finish lines correctly.
- Combined time of all runs determines ranking.
- **Missed gates must be hiked and complete correct path of travel** or result in disqualification.
- A crash resulting in loss of momentum is a disqualification.

Slopestyle Rules

- Competitors must follow run sheet order.
- 1 judged run, with top 10 advancing to a final judged run.

Scoring System

Race Points

- Points awarded based on year/gender/discipline category.
- 1st place = 100 points, 2nd = 99 points, 3rd = 98 points, etc.

Slopestyle Scoring

- Scored out of 100 based on overall impression.
- Judging criteria: Fluidity & Control, Technical Difficulty, Overall Impression.
- Falls result in deductions.

Awards

Individual Awards

- Top 3 per year/gender/discipline receive gold, silver, and bronze medals.
- Ties result in **duplicate medals** being awarded.

School Points

• Overall School Awards are based on cumulative points across all events.

Race Day Preparation

Pre-Race:

- Tuned skis & snowboards perform better on rough courses.
- Dress warmly long periods of waiting inside the dome can be cold.

Clothing & Gear:

- Label **all removable clothing items** with the athlete's name.
- Keep personal belongings in the team area.

Additional Tips:

- Bring extra clothing in case of temperature changes.
 Books or games can help pass time while waiting.
 Eat a good breakfast before arriving.
 Ensure athletes have food/drinks or money for the restaurant.
 Arrive early to avoid delays.
