

## RISK ASSESSMENT & MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

The purpose of the Risk Assessment and Management System (RAMS) is;

- To identify possible hazards
- To identify measures that will prevent, minimise or isolate those hazards
- In the event of harm, identify the action to control and minimise the extent of injury.

At all times Snowplanet has senior staff with a valid First Aid Certificate, who are trained to provide appropriate response in the case of accident or emergency. On-snow instructors carry a UHF radio to communicate with other members of the Snowplanet team.
