Entries

- Entries must be completed via Snowplanet's website under the Events section.
- Payment is required at registration and is **non-refundable**.

- Entries close 48 hours prior to each event.
- Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Events Manager and will incur a \$20 late fee.

Cost:

Event Schedule

- 7:45 AM Facility opens, number pick-up begins
- 8:30 AM All athletes must be on-site
- **8:45 AM** Athlete briefing
- **9:00 AM** Event start
- 3:00 PM (approx.) Event completion

Course Inspection

• Athletes may visually inspect the course from outside the fenced area before the race.

Eligibility

- Competitors must be enrolled as a student at the school they represent.
- Open to Primary and Intermediate students (Years 0–8).

Entry Requirements

- Helmets are **mandatory** (Helmets can be rented at Snowplanet).
- All athletes must be able to link turns in control from the top of Snowplanet and ride the platter lift unassisted.
- Schools may enter an unlimited number of athletes.

Event Format

Event #1 – Tuesday, 11 March

- Race: 2 runs, combined GS (all year levels)
- **Box Jam**: 1 practice run, 1 judged run, top athletes advance to a second judged run (**Years 3+ only**)

Event #2 – Tuesday, 13 May

- Race: 2 runs, combined GS (all year levels)
- Dual: GS times determine matchups, 1st vs. 2nd, school points only (Years 3+ only)

Event #3 – Tuesday, 5 August (Auckland Champs)

- Race: 2 runs, combined GS (all year levels)
- Slopestyle: 1 practice run, 1 judged run, top athletes advance to a second judged run (Years 3+ only)

Race Rules

- Racers must compete in run sheet order.
- Course inspection is visual only. This means no slip of the course.
- Combined time of both runs determines ranking.
- Two identical courses; each racer runs both.
- Missed gates must be hiked or result in disqualification.
- Missed start = disqualification.
- The **start list is final** and applies to all events.
- Individual medals will be awarded.

Box Jam & Slopestyle Rules

- Open to **Years 3**+ (*Year 1 & 2 may be approved upon request*).
- Competitors must follow run sheet order.

- 1 warm-up run before competition.
- 1 judged run, with top 3–10 advancing to a final judged run.
- Individual medals will be awarded.

Dual Format (Event #2 Only)

- Open to **Years 3**+ (*Year 1 & 2 may be approved upon request*).
- Matchups based on **GS results**.
- 4 points for the winner, 2 points for second place.
- No medals points contribute to school rankings.

Scoring System

Race Points

- Points awarded based on year/gender/discipline category.
- 1st place = 100 points, 2nd = 99 points, 3rd = 98 points, etc.
- If more than 100 competitors in a group, the scale will adjust.
- **Disqualifications (DQ)** due to equipment failure = 1 point.

Slopestyle & Box Jam Scoring

- Scored out of 100 based on overall impression.
- Judging criteria: Fluidity & Control, Technical Difficulty, Overall Impression.
- Best run counts.
- Falls result in deductions.
- Disqualification (DQ) due to equipment failure = 1 point.

Competition Rules

- Only the Chief of the Event, Race, or Slopestyle can issue disqualifications.
- Start orders cannot be changed after finalization.
- **Re-runs** are permitted only due to external interference (e.g., another racer or timing malfunction).
- Racers must pass through all gates and finish lines correctly.
- No competitor, manager, or parent may forerun or maintain the course.

Protests

- Protests must be in writing on an official protest form.
- A \$100 non-refundable fee applies.
- Protest jury: Event Manager, Chief of Race/Slopestyle, and one course official.
- Jury decisions are final.

Awards

Individual Awards

- Top 3 per year/gender/discipline receive gold, silver, and bronze medals.
- Ties result in **duplicate medals** being awarded.

School Points & Overall Series Awards

- Schools earn points per event.
- No medals for individual school event results.
- Overall School Series Awards are based on cumulative points across all events.
- Series winners announced on Tuesday, 5 August 2025.

Auckland Championships (Tuesday, 5 August)

- Final event of the Schools Challenger Cup and Auckland Primary & Intermediate Snowsports Championships.
- Points count toward both the Auckland Champs and overall series standings.
- School awards will be presented for Auckland Champs and overall series winners.

Race Day Preparation

Pre-Race:

- Tuned skis & snowboards perform better on rough courses.
- Dress warmly long periods of waiting inside the dome can be cold.

Clothing & Gear:

- Label all removable clothing items with the athlete's name.
- Keep personal belongings in the team area.

Additional Tips:

- Bring extra clothing in case of temperature changes.
- Books or games can help pass time while waiting.
- Eat a **good breakfast** before arriving.
- Ensure athletes have food/drinks or money for the restaurant.
- Arrive early to avoid delays.
